- 44. Explain the characteristics of the Newly Industrialized Economies (NIEs), including the Asian Tigers, of the Pacific Rim that allowed those nations to quickly industrialize and become global economic powers. Be specific. (Chapter 34)

- 45. Discuss global population growth since WWII, and compare the impact of population growth in developing and in industrialized nations since WWII. Your discussion should also include altered migration patterns. (Chapter 34)
- 46. What is globalization? How has this affected the global politics, nuclear proliferation, and the world economy? (Chapter 35)
- 47. Since the end of the Cold War, cultural imperialism has replaced overt political imperialism as a worldwide issue. Briefly explain cultural imperialism and how is has spread. (Chapter 35)
